

Privacy Policy

Thank you for visiting Fieldman, Rolapp & Associates' Web site. We are pleased to provide you this Privacy Policy to inform you of our practices with respect to the collection and use of information about visitors to our Web site.

Your Consent

By using our Web site and providing your personal information you consent to our collection and use of your personal information in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to this Privacy Policy, please do not use our Web site.

Information We Do Collect

When you visit our Web site you may provide us with two types of information; personal information you knowingly choose to disclose that is collected on an individual basis and Web site-uses information collected on an aggregate basis as you and others browse our Web site.

Personal Information You Provide To Us

You may voluntarily provide us personally identifiable information such as your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address and company name. If you choose to correspond with us through e-mail, we may retain the content of your e-mail messages together with your e-mail address and our responses.

How We Use The Information You Provide To Us

We use personal information provided by users for purposes of administering our business activities or responding to inquiries. Occasionally, we may also use the information we collect to notify you about important changes to our Web site, new developments or for advertisement purposes. You may notify us at any time if you do not wish to receive these notices by emailing us at webmaster@fieldman.com.

Sharing Information With Third Parties

[Except as specifically described in this Privacy Policy, we will not, without your specific prior consent, sell, trade or transfer your personally identifiable information to third parties other than authorized third parties. We do not give access to data on individual transactions to third parties, other than as described in the Privacy Policy.]

Certain Disclosures

We may disclose your personal information if required to do so by law or if we believe that such action is necessary to (a) conform to the law; (b) protect our rights and property, our Web site, the users of our site and/or our affiliated parties; and/or (c) act under circumstances to protect the safety of users or the site, us or third parties.

Information We Gather From Your Use of Our Web Site

Similar to other commercial Web sites, our Web site utilizes a standard technology called "cookies" to collect information about how our Web site is used. A cookie is a very small piece of data, which often includes an anonymous identifier stored on the user's computer tied to information about the user. When you visit a Web site, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store that file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each Web site can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a Web site to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other sites. You can choose to disable cookies by following the procedure suggested by your particular browser. If you choose to disable cookies in you browser, you may still be able to access our Web site depending on where you are in the site.

We also gather certain information about the use of our site by our visitors using a process that does not by itself identify a specific individual, commonly referred to as "log files." This information is then compiled and analyzed in a way that does not identify our visitors personally. The information may include the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) a visitor of our site has just come from, which URLs have been visited within our site, what browser is being used and what Internet Protocol (IP) address a visitor used to get to our site.

How We Use the Information We Collect from Cookies

As you use our website, the site uses its cookies to differentiate you from other users. Cookies, in conjunction with our Web server's log files, allow us to calculate the aggregate number of people visiting our Web site and which parts of the site are most popular. This helps us gather feedback in order to constantly improve our Web site. Cookies do not allow us to gather any personal information about you and we do not store any personal information that you provide to us in your cookies.

Warning Regarding Security of Transmission

Information provided from you on our Web site is via an unsecured internet transmission. Furthermore, e-mail is not recognized as a secure medium of communication. You should not send private or confidential information to us by e-mail or otherwise in connection with our site.

Children's Privacy

Please do not submit any information if you are under 18 years of age, unless you have the consent of your parent or guardian. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 18. If we learn that we have personal information on a child under the age of 18, we will promptly delete that information.

What About Other Websites Linked to Our Website?

We are not responsible for the practices employed by Web sites linked to or from our Web site nor the information or content contained therein. Please remember that when you use a link to go from our Web site to another Web site, our Privacy Policy is no longer in effect. Your browsing and interaction on any other Web site is subject to that Web site's own rules and policies.

Changes to Policy

We reserve the right to occasionally change our Privacy Policy at our discretion. We will bring any such changes to your attention by posting such changes to our Privacy Policy, our homepage and other places we deem appropriate so our users are always aware of what information is collected, how it is used and under what circumstances, if any, it is disclosed. If, however, we are going to use your personally identifiable information in a manner different from that stated at the time of collection, we will notify you by posting a notice on our Web site for 30 days.
